**PITTOCK MANSION**

Pittock Mansion is located off Burnside Street about one mile from the intersection of 23<sup>rd</sup> and Burnside. Turn onto Barnes road and follow the signs to the Mansion. Park in the lot, grooming will be on lawn in front of the Mansion.

Show Hours - Noon - 4:00 pm Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup>**

**GENERAL SHOW RULES**

1. This show will adhere to the American Rose Society Rose Show rules. **All** amateur rose growers are welcome to exhibit in this show. There are no fees associated with entering.
2. Entries will be from 6:30-9:30 am.
3. Only PRS, ARS, or PNW entry tags are acceptable and will be available at the show.
4. Only containers provided by the PRS are to be used except for entries in the artistic section.
5. Proper identification and classification is the responsibility of the exhibitor, however, assistance will be available.
6. Unwanted growth may be removed from specimens, but nothing may be added.
7. No wedging (including detached leaves) or supporting material may be used.
8. An entry may be disqualified if it: 1) is misnamed, or misclassified; 2) is stem on stem; 3) has foreign substance on the foliage, stem, or bloom; 4) is not disbudded if required; or (5) is in violation of PRS show rules.
9. There are special sections for novice and junior exhibitors, but they are permitted to enter roses anywhere in the show if they choose.
10. Five or more entries of the same variety shall constitute a separate class.
11. The decisions of the judges are final.
12. Trophies will be awarded at 3:00 pm on Saturday. Winners should be present to accept their trophies at that time or should make arrangements with the trophy chair, Gretchen Humphrey, or Show Chair, Rich Baer for later pick-up. Ribbons will be mailed.

13. In consideration of no charges being assessed to exhibit in this show, each exhibitor agrees that the PRS and the Pittock Mansion will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to any person or property; however, care will be exercised to protect exhibits on display.
14. All roses entered in this show become the property of the PRS and will be dispensed with after the show according to the directives of the show chair.
15. In sections where all color classes are not represented, the first word in the color class will determine where the entry should go. For example, an Orange-Pink rose goes in the Orange section.
16. **Mini-Flora roses have their own classes and should not be entered with the mini roses unless noted to include them.**

## VIRTUOSO (EASY) CLASSES

### MINI AND MINIFLORAS (OPEN TO EVERYONE)

- A **Miniature Competition.** Three individual blooms, three varieties, exhibited in one container.
- B **Miniature Bloom Progression.** Three stems, one variety. One bud showing color, one bloom at exhibition stage, and one fully open (stamens must show). Exhibit should be staged with the bud at the top, fully open rose at the bottom. Exhibited in one container.
- C **Rainbow Hues Challenge.** Five blooms, each bloom from a different major color class: white, yellow, apricot, orange, pink, red, mauve, or russet - blends are acceptable. Displayed in five containers, each labeled.

To be placed by the exhibitor and shall not be moved by the show staff.

- D **Miniature English Rose Box.** Six **DIFFERENT** varieties, exhibited in a miniature rose box. No foliage allowed. PRS boxes only.
- E **Miniature Colorama.** Four miniature roses displayed in one container. One white, one yellow, one pink, and one red, blends are acceptable.
- F **Rose in a Champagne Glass.** One miniature rose, exhibition form, no foliage, displayed floating in a champagne glass. Glasses provided by PRS.
- G **Miniature Vase of Five.** Five blooms, five stems, one variety, exhibited in one container.
- H **Miniature Potpourri Bowl.** Miniature roses, mixed varieties or a single variety, displayed in one container. Judged 60% on overall effect and 40% on bloom quality. This is a horticultural entry and stem and foliage are an integral part of the exhibit. A container with oasis will be provided by the PRS.
- I **Miniature Spray Challenge.** Three sprays of three different varieties displayed in three containers each labeled. Exhibit to be placed by the exhibitor and shall not be moved by show staff.
- J **Miniature Rose Portrait.** One exhibition form miniature rose exhibited in a picture frame with one leaf with either three or five leaflets (need not be attached to the rose). Frames will be provided by the PRS. **(One entry per Household)**
- K **Three Open Blooms.** Three open blooms, three stems, consisting of either three different varieties **OR** three of the same variety of fully open blooms, (stamens must show) staged in one container.
- L **Miniature Rose Palette.** Five miniature exhibition form blooms, five different varieties, five different color classes arranged left to right on the palette going from light to dark color classes. **(One entry per household)**

## ROSE ARRANGEMENT RULES

1. Roses must be the dominant flower.
  2. Roses should be correctly named.
  3. No artificial plant materials may be used.
  4. Only one entry per class is allowed.
  5. ARS arrangement rules will be followed.
  6. Dimensions in inches are for the maximum overall size of the arrangement, which includes height, width, and depth.
- Trophies will be awarded for the best traditional, modern/creative, oriental, and personal adornment.**
